

APPLICATION DEADLINES



ARRIVAL AND ORIENTATIONS

We request that students arrive a few days before the start of lectures in order to enroll and attend the orientations.

When a student arrives in Russia, they must visit the International Students office (r.306) on the very first day after arrival to get registration.

Upon additional request (please contact your admissions officer), we can arrange pick-up from the Nizhny Novgorod airport or railroad station to the University.

VISA PROLONGATION

In order for your visa to be eligible for the extension, the Russian Migration Service requires you to arrive in the Russian Federation 1 month prior to the date of expiry of your student entry visa.

TRANSCRIPT OF RECORDS

Upon successful completion of their programme, international students receive certificates with the information in English or Russian about courses passed, exams taken and grades received. These certificates also include information about the workload of each discipline based on the unified European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS).



RECOMMENDED LANGUAGE SKILLS

Students must either have good Russian language skills to apply to programmes taught in Russian or, respectively, a good level of English to apply to programmes taught in English (B2 according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages).

LANGUAGE SUPPORT PROGRAMS

INDIVIDUAL RUSSIAN LANGUAGE PROGRAM

The programme is designed for international students who prefer to study Russian individually (min. 10 academic hours a week)

Duration: 4 weeks minimum

Cost: 1100 rubles per one academic hour

RUSSIAN LANGUAGE PROGRAM

The programme is designed for international students interested in learning Russian. The classes are conducted in groups (22 academic hours a week).

Duration: one academic year if started in the fall semester, and one year and a half if started in the spring semester.

Cost: 115 000 rubles for 1 academic year and 155 000 for 1.5 academic year programmes

SUMMER SCHOOL

The programme is designed for international students with the beginner's level of Russian who plan to improve their knowledge of the language. The classes are conducted in groups (22 academic hours a week). The programme includes Russian language and country studies classes, and a range of social events.

Duration: 3 weeks (July, 2019).

Cost of tuition: 35 000 rubles


ACCOMODATION

UNN provides support for international students in finding accommodation.



- Located on campus not far from the city center.
- All rooms have Internet access.
- Shared bathrooms and kitchens are located on each floor.
- Students also have access to special study rooms.

Cost: Standard accommodation (3 pers. per room) at the dormitory costs 10400 rubles per academic year (i.e. 1040 rubles per month).

HEALTH INSURANCE

We strongly recommend all our students to purchase Russian health insurance. Students will have the opportunity to buy Russian health insurance upon arrival at Visa and Immigration Support Office (room 306). It costs about 3000 rubles per semester (standard price for students from all health insurance companies).


SCHOLARSHIPS

International students can receive a government scholarship to study in Russia. The Ministry of Education and Science of the Russian Federation awards the scholarship on a competitive basis. The scholarship can cover tuition for any programmes at UNN including degree programmes (in English or Russian), study abroad programmes/internships, Russian language programmes, and Summer Schools.

DO NOT REQUIRE VISA

Citizens of Azerbaijan, Armenia, Belarus, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Moldova, Tajikistan, Uzbekistan, Ukraine

REQUIRE VISA

For students, who are citizens of other countries, the University addresses the general Administration for Migration Issues of the Interior Ministry of Russia to launch the invitation process. The Administration issues an invitation letter approximately 6 weeks after the University's official request. The original invitation letter is required in order to obtain a three-month student visa at the local Russian Embassy. If a student wants to study for longer, they can have UNN extend their visa without leaving the country. One month prior to the expiration of their visa, they should come to the Dean's office (room 306) with all the necessary documents.

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

ESTIMATED COST OF LEAVING

Approximately €250 - €350 per month to cover minimum living costs in Russia

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Students can buy a monthly ticket at the current price of 1200 rubles for unlimited public transportation within the city of Nizhny Novgorod (500 rubles for unlimited bus transportation)
